The Masters Division is the highest recognized amateur level of pool. This year, the ACS (American Cue Sports Alliance) holds their national event immediately following the BCA and VNEA events. With one dominating year under their belt, the new, "bigger and badder," team has its sights set on an unprecedented victory over all three.

The 2006 Colorado Women's Masters Team has a few new faces on it; but no one you shouldn't recognize. Some life and career changes brought last year's *Mile High Masters* their separate ways.

Veteran Master Players Bonnie Plowman and Julie Schultz (with numerous national wins between them) remain on the team, bringing on board Samm Diep (recent BCA 9 Ball Champion), Chris Honeman (recent US Amateur qualifier representing Colorado), and Katrina Games (another veteran Master with recent success in the men's open divisions).

As the ladies gear up for this year's Vegas tournaments, they invite both individual and corporate sponsors to support their mission in proving they are the strongest women's pool team in the nation.

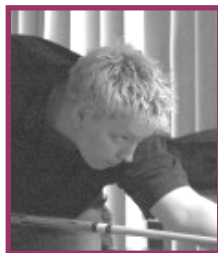
